

Extension of Reciprocal Borrowing Privileges Within RAILS

The Skokie Public Library Board of Trustees extends Reciprocal Borrowing privileges to all public library members of RAILS who are in good standing with their home libraries, with a limit of ten items per cardholder per visit to the Skokie Public Library. The Board takes this action with the understanding that funding of delivery in support of reciprocal borrowing is the highest priority for State funding to RAILS. Should State funding of interlibrary delivery cease, the Board reserves the right to reconsider its Reciprocal Borrowing Policy. Approval of reciprocal borrowing to residents of library service areas within RAILS in no way obligates the Skokie Public Library to support RBP through payments to RAILS.

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Skokie Public Library Board of Trustees.
