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What is Publisher?

- A desktop publishing program
- Can be used to create a variety of documents
 - Newsletters
 - Cards
 - Brochures
 - Certificates
 - Flyers
 - Business cards
 - Many more!



How is Publisher SKOKIE HOW IS FORMER PUBLIC LIBRARY different from other MS Office programs?

- Publisher is an **object based** program—you move objects • around the workspace to produce a publication.
- A program like MS Word is linear—you type letter after \bullet letter, word after word, paragraph after paragraph to produce a document.

Adapting Templates

- You have several options to adapt a template before you start:
- Choose a pre-set color scheme
- Change the font for the whole publication
- Insert your personal or business information
- Layout and page size options

- You can also create your own personalized templates
- You can save a Publisher file as a template to reuse by going to the File Tab and selecting "Save As"
- In the "Save As" menu, change the file type from Publisher Files to Publisher Template.
- You can also use this option to save to an older version of publisher.
