What is Google Drive?

- Free cloud or web storage service (15 GB) shared with Gmail and Google Photos. It allows you to store pictures, videos, documents online
- Has built-in suite of editing tools to create documents, spreadsheets, presentations, drawing, forms and more
- Drag and drop files capability to upload files and folders easily to and from the Google Drive
- Ability to collaborate and share files, photos, etc.

As mentioned earlier, here are a few built-in office suite similarities: Google Doc = MS Word Google Sheets = MS Excel Google Slides = MS PowerPoint
