## 1. Menu Bar

a. The Menu Bar appears along the top of your screen.
b. The time, date, and connectivity are on the top right.

c. The Apple Menu and other contextual menu options appear on the left.

## 2. Windows

a. To open or close a window, look the three round buttons in the upper left of the window.
i. Red: close window
ii. Yellow: minimize

iii. Green (when available): resize

## 3. The Dock

a. The Dock appears along the bottom of your screen.


## 4. Finder

a. The Finder icon appears on the far left of the Dock.

b. Files, folders, and applications appear in the white pain on the right.

c. Frequently visited places appear on the left pane of the Finder window.
