
What is Facebook?

Worldwide there are **1.86 billion** active monthly users.







Why Facebook?


- Keep up with friends, family, and acquaintances around the world.

Signing Up

- To register for a Facebook account you need: email address, must be at least 13 years old
- Go to www.facebook.com
- If you see the signup form, fill out your name, email address, or phone number, password, birthday, and gender. If you don't see the form, click **Sign Up**, then fill out the form.
- Once you sign up, you'll need to confirm your email address or phone number. It will send you either an email or a text message to help you confirm your account.


