
Intro to Apple Computer Desktop Tour Reference Sheet

1. Menu Bar

a. To open or close a window, look the three round buttons in the

3. The Dock

a. The Dock usually appears along the bottom of your screen.

4. Finder

a. The Finder icon appears on the far left of the Dock.




b. Files, folders, and applications appear in the white pane on the

window.




d. The grey bar along the top of the Finder window gives options for
