How do I find out my Apple ID?

- On a computer, go to <u>www.icloud.com</u>, click on "Forgot Apple ID or password" and follow the steps and instructions for recovering your Apple ID (see Figure 1).
- On your iPhone or iPad, go to the Settings app and open the first option—it should show the name associated with the Apple ID signed in to the device. Look for the email address listed below the name (see Figure 2). This is your Apple ID

How do I reset my Apple ID password?

- On a computer, go to <u>www.icloud.com</u>, click on "Forgot Apple ID or password" and follow the steps and instructions for resetting your password (see Figure 1).
- On your iPhone or iPad, go to the Settings app and open the first option—it should show the name associated with the Apple ID signed into the device. Tap "Password & Security" (see Figure 2) and "Change Password." Enter your passcode and enter a new password as instructed.
