
BOOMbox at Home DIY Fluffy Slime

Do you love playing with slime? This <u>borax-free fluffy slime recipe</u> is loads of fun and completely customizable. All you need are some simple ingredients found at home.



Supplies

- 1/2 cup clear or white PVA school glue
- 1 tablespoon saline solution (must contain boric acid and sodium borate)
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 cups foaming shaving cream
- Optional: food coloring
- Bowl, spoon, measuring cups and spoons

Instructions

- Place 3 cups of shaving cream in a bowl. You can also experiment with using less shaving cream for different textures.
- If you want, add a couple of drops of food coloring.
- Add 1/2 cup of glue to the shaving cream and gently mix.
- Add 1/2 teaspoon of baking soda and mix.
- Add 1 tablespoon of the saline solution to the mixture and start whipping. If your slime is too sticky, add a few more drops of the saline solution.
- Once you get the mixture thoroughly whipped and incorporated, you can pull and knead it with your hands.
