# **Get Crafty! Make a Paper Heart**

## **Supplies:**

- Piece of paper
- Writing utensil (pencil, pen, or marker)
- Scissors
- White crayon (or craft glue and table salt)
- Coloring supplies (crayons, paint, glitter, colorful paper)



#### Instructions:

• Cut out a large heart from a piece of paper. Fold your paper in half, draw half of a heart along the crease, then cut along your drawn line. Unfold for a full heart.







• Using a white crayon or craft glue, carefully outline your heart, then draw three 3 white lines across it to create shapes. This will help give it a mosaic feel. If using glue, try sprinkling with white table salt to thicken the lines. Dump any excess salt. Let glue dry completely.



- Using markers, crayons, paints, glitter, or any other craft supplies you already have at home, fill in shapes between your lines.
- Hang your craft heart in your front window as a message of hope.

# Get Outside! Make a Chalk Heart

## **Supplies:**

- Masking tape
- Sidewalk chalk

### Instructions:

- Outline a large heart on your sidewalk using masking tape.
- Create shapes by placing tape across the inside of the heart.





- Color in each shape.
- Pull up all the tape. The tape should have protected the sidewalk in between each color block to create a mosaic. Your neighbors will love seeing your message of encouragement when they go for a walk.

## Want to do more?

How else can you let your Skokie spirit shine through with mosaic hearts? Try painting one on your front window or creating a decal for your family's car. Try a lawn sign or window banner. Use whatever colors best show your community spirit. Be creative!

Go for a walk in your neighborhood and count the hearts you see.
