Supplies

- Paper doll template
- Three markers
- Scissors (not included)

Instructions

- Color the paper dolls and their clothing using the markers.
- Carefully cut out the dolls and the clothes. Make sure to include the tabs on the clothes—that's how you'll put them on the dolls.
- If you'd like, add additional embellishments to the clothes like glitter or feathers.
